Secret for Avoiding Germs

This just in: a secret way to avoid many of the germs we encounter on a day-to-day basis! But first, a list of the top germ-infested spots you encounter in your daily routine:

- ATM buttons
- Computer keyboards
- TV/DVD/Game remote controls
- Telephones
- Handbags & wallets
- Doorknobs

Before you decide to stay home the rest of your life (which won't help unless you swear off your computer, TV and phone), here's the simplest solution. Wash your hands a few times a day with plain soap and water.

Studies show this method is far more effective – and less costly – than the wide range of wipes and sprays on the market. Avoid antibacterial products unless you have an excellent reason for using them: they kill both good and bad bacteria and contribute to antibiotic resistance.

One more caution: very frequent hand washing can be counter- productive. If four is good, twenty is not necessarily better!
